### Amend Article VI, Item A:

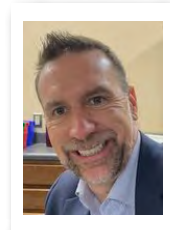

[REMOVE: at other associations, included but not limited to, American Correctional Association, American Probation and Parole Association, National Association of Justice Information Systems.] This position shall serve without compensation, but may receive reimbursement for out-of-pocket expenses incurred on behalf of the Association.

### Add Article VI, Item B.8:

Appoint Technology Director whose responsibility will be to provide technology leadership to the Board, manage CTA technology assets and contracts, manage operation of the association website, and manage technology implementations for Summits and CTA operations.

**Zacc Allen, Chief Information Officer, Virginia Department of Corrections**

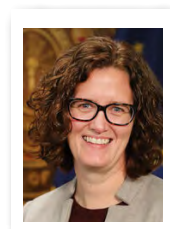

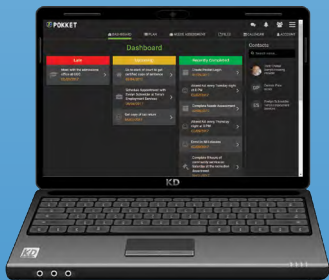

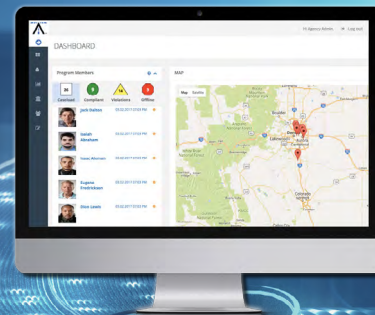
